<u>The Criteria</u>: The Andrew McMorris Foundation Aviation Grant was created to honor the memory of a very special twelve-year-old boy who was tragically killed by a drunk driver while hiking with his Boy Scout troop in the fall of 2018.

Andrew was full of life and positive spirit. His charisma was contagious. A friend to everyone, Andrew's passion and zest for life was unrelenting, and he never wanted to waste a moment. He loved music, scouting, painting, skiing, hiking, dancing and traveling, but most of all he loved aviation. Ever since he could walk, Andrew dreamed that one day he would become a pilot and had already taken his first flight in AeroCamp at Mid Island Air Flight School in the summer of 2018.

The Andrew McMorris Foundation would like to award scholarships in the amount not to exceed \$1000 to a student 6th-12th grade who is interested in attending a Flight School Summer Camp or would like to take Flying Lessons.. AMF would like to fuel the interest of passionate youth aviation enthusiasts like Andrew by sponsoring grants allowing students to gain a better understanding of the aviation community and give young people a unique opportunity to explore the world of aviation and aerospace.

The student candidate for this award should be able to demonstrate their passion for aviation as well as qualities of kindness, care, selflessness and a concern for others including a commitment to the community, their education and a strong desire to experience an impactful life with aspirations to obtain their pilot's license.

#### **Eligibility & Requirements**

- Applicant must be a 6<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> grade student who demonstrates their passion for aviation.
- Applicant must have **contacted a Flight School** with their intentions to attend Summer Camp or take Flying Lessons.
- Applicant should be in **good academic standing and an aspiring pilot.**
- Applicant must provide **one letter of recommendation** detailing their passion for aviation.
- Applicant must have completed a **minimum of 10 hours community service**.
- Applicant must complete an **activity resume** that includes honors, awards, scholarships, extra-curricular activities and community service hours.
- Applicant must submit a **300-word personal essay**:
  - o "What drives your passion for aviation and how has that affected other areas of your life? (In short, tell us why you want to fly and include any personal influences and what involvement you have had in aviation so far.)
- Applicant must complete the **attached 2024 application**.
- Payment will be made directly to Flight School after the student and guardian has signed all necessary paperwork including the Release from Liability & Statement of Voluntary Consent Form.

**Awards Available:** Aviation Grants up to \$1000 for either Summer Camp or Flying Lessons.
